Work plan/budget

Training

Parent training: “Partnering with a Purpose: Communication and Collaboration for Interagency Teams” update:

- The group reviewed the catalog description for Moorhead. It is set for February 10 from 6 – 7:30.
- The description is due to Hawley in December or January.
- Jackie will bring up the idea of training for Moorhead teachers (especially new teachers) with the leadership team tomorrow.
 - EIS/Head Start don’t have kids on Fridays, so that might be a good day for them.
 - Training for teachers of older kids would have to be on a different day.
 - Maybe invite service providers and county staff
- Issues
 - Who informs families – address at training? County knows who has outside services. School informs parents that they can bring other people to IEP meetings, but not necessarily that having public-paid service plus IEP qualifies child for IIP.
 - Does brochure have contact information for who to go to for more information about IIP?
